The Interreg SUDOE 21-27 Programme

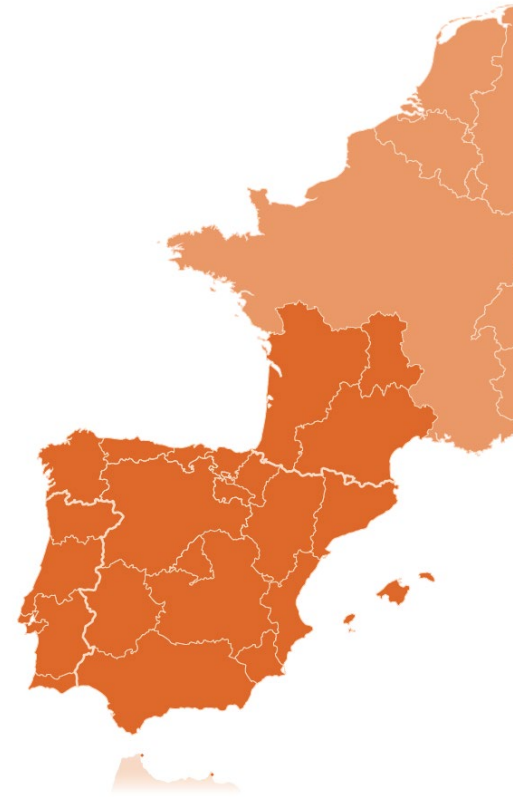


In a nutshell:

ERDF programme to address the common challenges faced by the SUDOE regions—climate change, social cohesion, and territorial balance—through cooperation projects between entities in the Member States that make up this area.

26 regions and 68,2 million inhabitants.

2021-2027 period budget: 115.3 million euros.

- **3 Open calls** to select the best innovative businesses in the manufacturing industries for green transition.
- **6-months transnational programme of mentoring and business acceleration services** (in-kind services of a value up to 20.000€) promoted by business support organisations, clusters, universities and corporations from **France, Portugal, and Spain**.
